AMAC Opposes the "Inflation Reduction Act"

AMAC Action sent a letter to Senate Minority Leader Mitch McConnel (KY) and Majority Leader Chuck Schumer (NY) stating the association's strong opposition to the so-called "Inflation Reduction Act"

This bill will spend billions on top of the trillions of dollars already spent by this Congress that led to this inflationary crisis. AMAC is also very concerned about the Medicare prescription drug price "negotiation" provision contained in this legislation, which is government price-fixing of pharmaceuticals. Price-fixing drugs leads to a reduction in research and development, which means fewer new therapies, artificial drug shortages, and rationing.
