AMAC members were involved in several election integrity issues in states throughout the country in February. They sent thousands of messages opposing ranked-choice voting legislation in Arizona, Utah, Illinois, and Idaho. **AMAC** members in New Mexico responded to their state legislature's attempts to push through bad "voters rights" bills. In Wyoming, **AMAC** members contacted their state Senate to successfully support a bill to prevent the opposition party and unaffiliated voters from crossing over to vote in Republican primaries.
