Dear Senator Paul,

Passing the "One Subject at a Time Act" into law will make government more transparent, make legislation easier to understand, and limit incomprehensible and potentially damaging omnibus bills. This is a concept whose time is past due and an effort we appreciate you championing.

The salient elements to note are:

- This bill sets its own example by addressing a single topic, in plain language, that a bill should present only one subject at a time, and that the title of the bill accurately reflects the content of the bill.
- This bill would prevent future appropriations bills from affecting law not associated with those appropriations.
- A set of consequences are designed for violating the intent of this bill when it becomes law.

AMAC thanks you, Senator Paul, for your vision and leadership with introducing this important legislation that would benefit all Americans. We are pleased to offer our organization's full support for S. 287, the "One Subject at a Time Act."
